 - 23.1 Notices will be published in the Parish Council newsletter, on the Parish Council website and on Facebook explaining the criteria for projects and asking residents to submit proposals by 7 May. Residents will be asked to give their full name and address with their proposals and an indication of the sum of money to be allocated to the project. Any Councillor proposing a project will also be asked for an indication of costs.
 - 23.2 The Clerk, the Chair and the Vice-Chair will assess the proposals against the criteria for CIL projects and the available funding and identify any proposals that do not comply with the criteria or that will be too expensive for the funding available. Councillors will be given information of all proposals submitted and reasons for the non-compliance of any projects.
 - 23.3 There will be an extraordinary meeting of the Council on Monday 17 June to select and prioritise projects.
