

District Councillor Report - Parish Council Meeting June 2021

Ackworth

Grass cutting – part of the grass hadn't been cut on Dando Way next to Mount Pleasant, this has now been completed.

Gullies – some gullies on Lee Lane and near Hinnits have had a cleansing. Further cleanings work will be carried out.

30mph signs – new signs have been ordered for Station Road near the train line/The Rustics area.

Flooding - Station Road, Low Green and Westfield Grove/Drive area. Work in this area is currently ongoing, including investigations, site visits, meetings and gullie cleansing. Direct regular communication is passed to all involved in this area including residents who have provided contact details, this is helping to squash misleading information being circulated via social media.

Active and Inspired funding – District Councillor had access to the Active and Inspired fund which has now been allocated to provide some services from WFYouth for youth workers in Ackworth and Upton. Upton Rugby Club has also received some funding and will be working with WFYouth and District Councillors.
