

Regulations under section 78 of the Coronavirus Act 2020 state that Parish Councils only have the powers to hold virtual meetings up to and including 6 May.

Government guidance does not permit face to face meetings until after the 17 May and legislation requires that the Council must hold its annual meeting before the 31 May. Therefore the Annual Meeting due to be held on 10 May cannot go ahead.

At the extra ordinary Parish Council meeting held on 28 April 2021 the Parish Council approved a change in arrangements for the Annual Parish Council meeting to be held on Wednesday 5 May 2021.

Due to the exceptionally high work load of the Administration Team there is not time to prepare the usual agenda for the Annual Meeting which will now take place on 5 May.

The agenda will have 5 items, two items of which are; the appointment of a Chair for the forthcoming year and giving delegated powers to the Clerk to enable the business of the Parish Council to continue until the next scheduled meeting to be held on 21 June.
